1 Samuel 17: 32-50

34 But David persisted. "I have been taking care of my father's sheep and goats," he said. "When a lion or a bear comes to steal a lamb from the flock, 35 I go after it with a club and rescue the lamb from its mouth. If the animal turns on me, I catch it by the jaw and club it to death. 36 I have done this to both lions and bears, and I'll do it to this pagan Philistine, too, for he has defied the armies of the living God! (1 Sam 17:34-36)

41 Goliath walked out toward David with his shield bearer ahead of him, 42 sneering in contempt at this ruddy-faced boy. 43 "Am I a dog," he roared at David, "that you come at me with a stick?" And he cursed David by the names of his gods. 44 "Come over here, and I'll give your flesh to the birds and wild animals!" Goliath yelled.

45 David replied to the Philistine, "You come to me with sword, spear, and javelin, but I come to you in the name of the Lord of Heaven's Armies—the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. 46 Today the Lord will conquer you, and I will kill you and cut off your head. And then I will give the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel! (1 Sam 17:41-46)

The BackStory for content

- David was anointed by God through Samuel the Prophet
- He was the youngest of 8 least likely.
- David went back and forth to tend to the sheep with his father
- Israel and the Philistines at War
- A nine foot giant heckles Israel's army
- Jesse sends David to ground zero to deliver food and gifts to soldiers
- 1. God will put you in Position to do things no one else is willing to do.

a. In this snapshot of the story we find David pleading his case to the King that he is ready to face the Giant and has them stagnant as a nation.

b. For a month and a half, the Philistines teased and harassed Israel

- c. Take some time and reflect where God has brought you from.
 - i. Wisdom is taking learned moments and utilizing that knowledge to make better decisions. with his faith when facing the Giant
 - ii. Revelation -- God confirming your understanding for that moment
 - iii. Must have the right tools (tool example)
 - 1. Hammer -- used for breaking things and driving in things
 - 2. Lantern -- radiates light, Guide us through the Darkness
 - 3. Slingshot -- stepping back in order to move forward
 - 4. Pliers -- used for gripping and bending
- 2. Instills Confidence and Faith
 - a. Confidence means the feeling or belief that one can rely on
 - b. Faith means Strong belief in God, complete Trust or Confidence
 - c. Grounded in your Faith
 - i. Chosen last from all his brothers
 - ii. Trained to oversee a group of the unwilling
 - iii. Forced to fight the enemy in unconventional ways
 - iv. Blessed and Favored
- 3. How to Fight your Giant
 - a. Your enemy will be your footstool
 - b. Stand, Plant yourself in the Word (Psalm 1)
