

“OUT OF EGYPT” - PART II (EXODUS 4-6)

INTRO: Egypt represents trusting man rather than God (Isa. 31:1; 1Cor. 10:11). God is calling His people out of Egypt!

I. GOD GAVE MOSES INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING WHAT TO SAY TO PHARAOH AND ISRAEL’S ELDERS (Exodus 4).

A. Moses Struggles with His Call (Ex. 3:10, 13-14; 4:10-16).

B. God gave Moses three miraculous signs (Ex. 4:1-9, 17).

OUT OF EGYPT Step 6: *Expect God to do signs, miracles and wonders (Mark 16:15, 17-20).*

C. Moses goes back to Egypt (Ex. 4:18-20).

D. God tells Moses what to say to Pharaoh (Ex. 4:21-23).

OUT OF EGYPT Step 5: *Expect spiritual opposition.*

E. Moses & Aaron connect and address Israel’s elders and the people believe (Ex. 4:27-31).

II. MOSES & AARON GO TO PHARAOH, BUT THINGS GET WORSE (Exodus 5).

OUT OF EGYPT Step 4: *Spiritual leaders need to confront political leaders, even though they may not always respond positively.*

OUT OF EGYPT Step 5: *Expect spiritual opposition.*

A. Pharaoh didn’t know Israel’s God (Ex. 5:1-2).

B. Pharaoh increased Israel’s oppression (Ex. 5:3-14).

C. The people complained, but to no avail (Ex. 5:15-19).

D. Israel’s officers complain to Moses & Aaron (Ex. 5:20-21).

E. Moses went to the Lord about all this (Ex. 5:22-23).

1. Are you willing to suffer for Jesus (Acts 5:40-42)?

III. GOD REMINDS MOSES OF HIS COVENANT WITH ISRAEL (Exodus 6).

A. God will deal with Pharaohs (Ex. 6:1)!

B. God remembers His covenant with His people (Ex. 6:2-4).

C. God heard Israel’s cry & promised deliverance (Ex. 6:5-8).

1. God hears your cry and will lead you out of bondage!

D. The people’s pain blocked them from heeding (Ex. 6:9).

E. What God tells you to do will be challenging (Ex. 6:10-13)!

F. Persevere (Gal. 6:9; 1Cor. 15:58)!

CONCLUSION: Are you ready to step out of Egypt?
