

## “WHY A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW MATTERS - PART 2”

**REVIEW/INTRO:** A worldview is how we look at and understand the world, and therefore determines what we believe, how we live and how we respond to the things we face in life. A biblical worldview is a worldview that is primarily shaped by the Bible (rather than our culture). A biblical worldview requires that we believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God and is our primary source of truth and morality, regardless of culture (2Tim. 3:16-17; Ps. 12:7).

### **I. EVIDENCE OF THE BIBLE BEING GOD’S INSPIRED WORD.**

- A. Fulfilled prophecies (Examples: Prophecies of Christ).
- B. Transformed lives.

### **II. ABSOLUTE TRUTH IS AN ABSOLUTE NECESSITY FOR A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW.**

- 52% of self-identified Christians don’t believe this!
- A. Jesus is the absolute source of truth (Jn. 1:14, 17; 14:6).
- B. Jesus talks Truth & Freedom (Jn. 8:31-32; 17:17; 16:13).
  - 1. A true disciple of Jesus abides in His Word – has a biblical worldview (Jn. 8:31).
  - 2. Know the truth make you free & vice versa (Jn. 8:32).
  - 3. God’s word is truth that sanctifies us (Jn. 17:17).
  - 4. The Holy Spirit guides us into all truth (Jn. 16:13).
- C. Those who resist truth often attack those who embrace the truth (2Tim. 3:7-9; Jn. 7:7; 15:18-19; 1Jn. 2:15-17).
- D. The nature of truth is that it is narrow (examples).
- E. Why is it most people have no issues with absolute truth in most subjects, except morality?
- F. Disagreeing is not the same as hate or phobia!
