

## "HE RESTORES MY SOUL" (Psalm 23:3)

**INTRO:** As we began this new series let's get ready for God to take us on a deep journey out of our comfort zone!

## I. WHAT IS OUR SOUL?

- •We are made up of body, soul & spirit (1Thess. 5:23).
- A. **Body** the physical home of our spirit and soul.
  - 1. The body communicates through its 5 senses.
  - 2. Our body in its present state is mortal (2Cor. 4:16).
  - 3. At conversion our body (outward man) becomes the temple of the Holy Spirit (1Cor. 6:19-20).
  - 4. At death our body returns to the ground (Gen. 3:19).
  - 5. It's raised immortal at the resurrection (1Cor. 15:42-53).
- B. **Spirit** ["breath" (Gen. 2:7)] our innermost part.
  - 1. Corrupt at birth because of our sin nature.
  - 2. Transformed at conversion (1Cor. 6:17; Prov. 20:27).
  - 3. At death our spirit returns to the Lord awaiting the resurrection of the body (Ecc. 12:7; Lk. 23:42-43).
- C. **Soul** [Greek *psyche*] our mind, will and emotions.
  - 1. At conversion our soul to Christ and needs to be submitted to Christ and renewed (Rom. 12:1-2).
- D. **Heart** the spirit and soul together (inward man 2Cor. 4:16; Eph. 3:16-17; Heb. 4:12; 1Cor. 14:14).

[mind: Rom. 12:1-2; 1Cor. 2:16; Phil. 2:5; 4:8. Will: Matt. 6:10; Lk. 22:42. Emotions: Gal. 5:22-24; etc.]

## II. A DEEPER LOOK AT THE SOUL

- A. Our soul is under attack [devil & culture] (Ps. 57:4; 143:3-4).
- B. Our soul can be cast down & need attending to (Ps. 42:11).
- C. We need to choose with our will for our soul to seek and follow God (Ps. 63:8; 143:8; 146:1; Prov. 3:22; 19:16).
- D. We need to discipline our soul to bring it into alignment with God and His ways (Ps. 69:10; 103:1-2; 104:1; 131:2-3).
- E. We need to guard our soul (Prov. 22:5 21:23; 18:7).
- F. We need to take time to seek God to restore our soul and trust Him to do it (Ps. 33:20; 57:1; 62:1-2, 5; 130:5-6).
- G. God wants to satisfy your longing soul (Ps. 107:8-9; 116:7-8)!

**CONCLUSION:** Ask God to restore your soul and yield!
