

"SONS OF GOD - MANIFEST - Part 1"

INTRO: On this Easter Sunday morning we're going to focus on how Jesus' resurrection from the dead can impact our daily lives in power ways.

1. PAST – our initial salvation.

- A. Salvation requires Jesus' resurrection (1Cor. 15:14, 17)!
- B. Salvation requires us to believe this (Rom. 10:9).

2. FUTURE – our future resurrection.

A. Christ's resurrection guarantees ours (1Cor. 15:13, 20).

3. PRESENT – our present life as manifest sons of God.

- I. BECOMING MANIFEST SONS OF GOD (Rom. 8; etc.).
- A. At conversion we become sons of God (Jn. 1:12).
- B. We're adopted into God's family (Rom. 8:15; Eph. 1:5).
 - 1. The Holy Spirit regenerates our spirit (Titus 3:5).
 - 2. Our body becomes the Spirit's home (1Cor. 6:19-20) the Spirit that rose Christ from the dead (Rom. 8:11).
 - 3. The Spirit becomes one with our spirit (1Cor. 6:17).
 - 4. The Spirit bears witness to our sonship (Rom. 8:16) and to our adoption (Rom. 8:15; Gal. 4:5-6).
- C. As adopted sons we're joint heirs with Christ (Rom. 8:17).
- D. God sees us as sons, not slaves (Gal. 4:1-7; Jn. 15:15).

II. CREATION'S TRAVAIL FOR THE MANIFEST SONS OF GOD (Rom. 8:18-25).

- A. Don't let suffering cloud this vision (Rom. 8:18).
- B. Creation is waiting for sons to manifest (Rom. 8:19).
- C. The creation is subjected to futility (Rom. 8:20).
- D. The creation's deliverance is coming (Rom. 8:21).
- E. The whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs for the sons of God to be manifest (Rom. 8:22).
- F. Even Christians are groaning for this manifestation and our bodily resurrection (Rom. 8:23).
 - 1. We're called to persevere in this hope (Rom. 8:24-25).

CONCLUSION: Sons of God – manifest! It's time! The world is groaning for it. Let's not keep them waiting any longer!
