

"UNDERSTANDING THE FIVE FUNCTIONAL GIFTS TO THE CHURCH"

(Eph. 2:19-22; 4:11-16; 5:27) Pastor Mark Johnson

INTRO: Ephesians 4 gives us another glimpse of what a mature people of God look like, and how to get there.

I. WHAT A MATURE PEOPLE OF GOD LOOK LIKE (Eph. 4:12-16)

- 1. The saints are equipped for the work of ministry (v. 12a).
- 2. The body of Christ is built up and therefore strong (v. 12b).
- 3. The body of Christ walking in the unity of the faith (v. 13a).
- 4. The body walking in the knowledge of Jesus (v. 13b).
- 5. This brings us to maturity, manifesting Christ (v. 13c).
 - •As we mature, we become stable and aren't easily deceived by false doctrine and by deceitful people (v. 14).
- 6. The body of Christ speaks the truth in love (v. 15a).
 - A. Truth without love judgmental and legalistic.
 - B. Love without truth [moral] compromise.
- 7. The body of Christ grows up into Christ the head of His Church (v. 15b; John 15:7, 7).
- 8. Every member fulfilling their God-given function in the body, while staying connected and related (v. 16a).
 - •Result: the body grows & builds itself up in love (v. 16b).
- 9. Jesus is coming for a church that reflects His glory and lives holy (consecrated & obedient to God (Eph. 5:27)!

II. HOW DO WE ACHIEVE THIS GROWTH (Eph. 4:11)?

- A. Through the ministry of the five functional gifts (v. 11).
- B. God never took any of these gifts away from the church!
- C. All five are needed to be fully equipped and fully mature!
- D. In this series we will look at what these gifts are, how they properly function, & how that relates to each of us.

III. THE CHURCH IS TO BE BUILT ON AN APOSTOLIC & PROPHETIC FOUNDATION (Eph. 2:19-22).

- A. Believers are members (living stones 1Pet. 2:5) in the household of God (Eph. 2:19).
- B. We have to be "fitted together" before we can "grow together" (Eph. 2:21-22)!
- C. The end game is a holy priesthood as a dwelling place of God in the Spirit!
