INTRO: In this series we have worked our way through 1Corinthians chapters 12-14. Remember, corporate worship should be about the edification of the whole body and for that to happen, people need to understand what's going on.

I. DESIRE SPIRITUAL GIFTS (1Cor. 12:31; 14:1, 39)

II. STIR UP SPIRITUAL GIFTS (1Tim. 4:14; 2Tim. 1:6)

- A. Gifts require ongoing nurturing and stirring up.
- B. Stirring up spiritual gifts involves practice and use, as well as faith (Heb. 5:14; Rom. 12:6).

III. GUIDELINES FOR PROPHETIC MINISTRY IN THE CHURCH

- A. All things should be done decently and in order with honor and dignity (1Cor. 14:40).
- B. Every church should establish proper prophetic protocol.
 - 1. Proper protocol facilitates the effective use of the gifts.
 - 2. No order is out of order!
- C. General Guidelines
- D. Questions to consider before giving a word:
 - 1. Does the word fit the service's current flow & theme?
 - 2. Will the word take the service higher?
 - 3. Is the word meant just for you or for the whole body?
 - 4. Does the word edify, exhort, and comfort the body (1Cor. 14:3)? Avoid giving words of correction/rebuke.

IV. WHAT NOT TO PROPHECY:

- A. Any word that if you're wrong may be devastating.
- B. Be extremely cautious about prophesying specific timing.
- C. Avoid requesting or responding to requests to prophecy concerning specific areas.
