### While in the Wilderness of Sin They Camped at Rephidim

Rephidim - a place 250 km above sea level, a valley surrounded by mountains of sand, a place in the wildnerness

- A. What's the Rephidim in your life
  - i. Home of the Amalekites
    - 1. A peculiar people
    - 2. Isreal's first enemies
  - ii. A desolate place
    - 1. A place that's empty—a false sense of security
    - 2. A loveless place
    - 3. A lifeless place in the middle of the valley

#### 1. The Importance of Daily Water

- A. Water is essential for the cells and organs in our bodies to function, allowing us to engage in complex activities
- B. A lack of water causes:
  - i. Muscle fatigue
    - 1. Tired; working hard but not seeing the results
  - ii. Reduced cognitive processing
    - 1. The ability to recognize right and wrong
  - iii. Confused or dazed states of awareness
    - 1. Accept things for what they are
  - iv. Dry mouth
    - 1. Lacking the ability to shout out His praises

### 2. Lack of Water Causes a Contentious Environment

- A. Why was it so bad that they wanted to stone the leader after all he has done
  - i. They forgot how God has used him to get them to this point
  - ii. The heat of the wilderness
  - iii. Tiredness
  - iv. Anger because of lack of understanding
- B. A contentious environment can cause:
  - i. A lack of unity amongst the people
  - ii. Jealousy/Envy
  - iii. Separation
  - iv. Lack of patience

#### 3. Jesus is Our Water Provider

- A. Stand and strike the rock for the people may drink
  - i. We found out in Matthew that The Church is the Rock and Jesus is the Water
    - 1. Told Moses to stand:
      - a. To stand in front of your accusers
      - b. To be anchored in the Lord with the confidence in knowing that God is before us
      - c. To be ready
    - 2. Told Moses to strike:
      - a. Strike to pierce or penetrate
      - b. This is a call to action
      - c. Being ready to move at his very word
      - d. God needed to Strike the Church
    - 3. People may drink
      - a. Without the preacher the people will perish
      - b. How can they hear without the preacher
