

"THE COSTS & BENEFITS OF FOLLOWING JESUS"

INTRO: The Christmas story is an invitation to become a devoted follower of the Jesus whose birth we celebrate.

I. What does it Cost us to be a Devoted Follower of Jesus?

- A. Count the cost of following Jesus (Luke 14:28-30).
 - 1. The modern church has dumbed down the cost, which has produced immature Christians.
 - 2. Jesus said to be one of His disciples we must be willing to forsake all He asks us to (Luke 14:33).
 - 3. Salvation is a free gift, but discipleship costs you everything!
 - 4. Following Jesus is orienting your life around being His disciple (Matt. 4:19) and making disciples.
 - a. Follow Jesus His teachings, lifestyle & mission!
- B. Are these costs too high? It depends on what we get for what we pay. Do a cost/benefits analysis.

II. What are the Benefits of being a Jesus Follower?

A. We get Jesus & His Kingdom (Luke 1:30-33)!

- 1. He is great (v. 32a).
- 2. He is the Son of the Highest [Supreme] (v. 32b).
- 3. He reigns as King (vv. 32c-33a; Matt. 2:2).
- 4. His kingdom is eternal (v. 33b; Dan. 4:3; 7:14).
- 5. His kingdom becomes ours (Dn. 7:18; Lk. 12:32; 22:29).
- 6. His kingdom cannot be separated from Himself.
 - •Pursue Him even more than His kingdom!

B. We get a Treasure Hidden in a Field (Matt. 13:44)!

- 1. Diligently search for this hidden treasure (Matt. 6:33).
- 2. Joyfully pay the price for the treasure.
- 3. The value far exceeds the price!

C. We get a Pearl of Great Price (Matt. 13:45-46)!

- 1. Diligently search for this beautiful pearl (Matt. 6:33; Deut. 4:29; Prov. 8:17; Jer. 29:13).
- 2. Joyfully pay the price for the beautiful pearl.
- 3. The value far exceeds the price!

CONCLUSION: To be a fully devoted follower of Jesus will cost you everything, but you will gain even more!
