

“GETTING TO KNOW GOD’S SON - Hebrews 1”

INTRO: This morning I’m going to begin a series of messages working our way through the book of Hebrews whose primary theme is: **Getting to Know Jesus as Your High Priest.** We’ll cover other sub-themes as well.

I. INTRODUCING GOD’S SON (Heb. 1:1-3)

- A. God now speaks to us through His Son (vv. 1-2).
 - 1. In the O.T., God spoke through prophets.
 - 2. In the N.T., God speaks through Jesus.
 - a. Jesus is heir of all things (Ps. 2:7-8; 1Cor. 10:26; Col. 1:16-23) & Creator (Gen. 1:1, 26; Jn. 1:1-3; Col. 1:16-17).
- B. The Exaltation of God’s Son (v. 3).
 - 1. God’s Son reflects God’s glory & person (Jn. 14:9; 17:5; Col. 1:15).
 - 2. God’s Son keeps the world going (Col. 1:17).
 - 3. God’s Son washes away our sins (1Jn. 1:7).
 - 4. God’s Son is at the Father’s right hand (v. 13; Ps. 110:1; Mk. 16:19; 1Pet. 3:22).
 - 5. God’s Son is God (Jn. 1:1, 14; 5:18)!

II. GOD’S SON IS SUPERIOR TO ANGELS (Heb. 1:4-14)

- A. God’s Son has a more excellent name (Phil. 2:9-11).
- B. God didn’t call any angels His begotten Son (v. 5).
- C. God commanded angels to worship His Son (v. 6).
- D. Angels are God’s servants (vv. 7, 14).
- E. God’s Son’s throne is forever (v. 8).
- F. God’s Son rules with righteousness (v. 9a).
- G. God’s Son’s anointing (v. 9b; Jn. 3:34; Acts 10:38).
- H. The earth will perish, but God’s Son remains (vv. 11-12).

CONCLUSION: Focus more on God’s Son than angels! Let’s press in to get to know God’s Son better through the book of Hebrews! Jesus is God! God wants to speak to you through Jesus. Listen expectantly! Study Hebrews chapter 2.
