REVIEW/INTRO: Empathy is sympathizing with another person's situation. Empathy is a positive virtue but should be submitted to truth in love (Eph. 4:15; John 17:17; 8:32).

LIE #1: "Abortion is Health Care."

- 1. Abortion is forgivable (1John 1:9; Rom. 8:1).
- 2. Have we become somewhat numb to abortion?
- 3. Abortion is not reproductive freedom, but the freedom to terminate reproduction.
- 4. Abortion is not health care for the unborn, and is rarely health care for the mother.
- 5. "My body, my choice!"
 - A. What about the unborn child's body and choice?
 - B. Isn't the unborn child a separate body (organs, etc.)?
 - C. Why weren't they chanting that about the vaccine?

I. THE FLIP SIDE OF EMPATHY

- A. What about empathy for the innocent unborn child?
- B. Is taking the life of the unborn truly loving and just?
- C. Consider the brutal abortion procedures.
- D. Why are some more concerned about pets and animals?
- II. THE KEY TO THE ABORTION DEBATE: Is an unborn child a human being? Yes medically & biblically!
 - 1. "You shall not murder." (Ex. 20:13; Matt. 5:21-22)
 - 2. God considered Jeremiah (Jer. 1:5), John the Baptist (Lk. 1:15, 41, 44) & Jesus (Matt. 1:18, 23; Lk. 2:4-5, 12, 16) human beings before they were born!
 - 3. The 2nd greatest commandment (Matt. 22:39).

"Love does no harm to a neighbor; ..." (Rom. 13:9-10)

•Shouldn't this include a neighbor still in the womb?

4. God hates the shedding of innocent blood (Prov. 6:16-17).
